Duration: 30 minutes	
Aim	In this lesson plan students will learn how to move around their computers and tablets (navigating in the desktop, finding files) and also on the web. They will be introduced to the concept of a browser, the different existing types and how to use them.

Activities	 Task 1: Web browser (10min) Play this video to your students and ask some questions to check their understanding. Then ask them to provide a definition for each of these concepts: Links Navigation buttons Tabbed browsing Bookmarks and history Downloading files Plug-ins Task 2. Search on the internet (10min)



These are the results that google gave me. Have you received a similar result?





HANDOUT 2: Perform an Advanced Search

Let's see how to do an Advanced Search:



- 1. Write the text you are looking for, in Google search box and press Enter.
- 2. Click on Settings (as indicated by the arrow in the image).
- 3. Select Advanced Search.
- 4. In the "Find pages with" section, enter your search terms.
- 5. In the "Then narrow your results by" section, choose the filters you want to use. You can use one or more filters.
- 6. Click Advanced Search.

Now try to **do the same with an image** and choose some features you would like it to have (like size...)
