Lesson Plan 2 – What an Antivirus Software is		
Duration: 60 minutes		
Aim	This lesson plan aims to clarify the concept of "antivirus" and show its importance to keep equipment safe.

## 3. Task 3: Brainstorm about antivirus (35 mins)

- 3.1 Ask your students what they think when you say "antivirus". Tell them that in this exercise there are no right or wrong answers.
- 3.2 Jot down their answers on the whiteboard (5 mins)
- 3.3 Read out loudly all the answers, randomly, and discuss the results with the whole class. (you can go further if you think so) (30 mins)
  - 1. Why have certain types of answers turned up?
  - 2. Is there a similar connection between our physical health and antivirus?
  - 3. What else can we do to protect ourselves?
  - 4. Give some examples of antivirus software.
- 3.4 Find out a satisfactory definition in group (with a teacher's help to ensure that it is right).
  - 4. Task 4: Write a definition (10 mins)
- 4.1 Ask a volunteer to write the group definition on the cardboard *(see Handout 1)* and fix it on a board or wall in your classroom, near the cardboard done in the previous exercise.
  - 5. Task 5: Wrap up (5 mins)
