Lesson Plan 5 – What cyberbullying and cybercrime mean	
Duration: 90 minutes	
Aim	- This lesson plan aims to conceptualize cyberbullying and cybercrime.

Main Tasks	1. Task 1: Introduction to the concept (10 mins) 1.1 Introduction to the subject through PowerPoint (Teaching materials) 2. Task 2: Watch the video (2 mins)
	2.1 Start this task with a video https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=5TOIb0sS7fg 3. Task 3: Talk about what you saw in the film/ what it represents (20 mins) 3.1 Ask students what they saw in the film and let them speak freely.
	Then ask them if they have seen or know any similar situation. Provide them with clear examples so they can understand how easy






it is to be cyberbullied or do it oneself, even if we do not want to or are not aware of it.

- 4. Task 4: Ask learners to list two examples of cyberbullying and two examples of cybercrime. (50 mins)
- 4.1 Give learners some time to think, for discussion and Internet search, before you distribute Handout (*see Handout 1*) and ask them to write their answers on it.
 - 5. Task 5: Wrap up (8 mins)
